1. What is their philosophy of care?
2. Is there a support system available for breast-feeding?
3. What is their schedule of well child visits?
4. Is there developmental testing done at each visit?
5. Who takes calls for them when they are off and on the weekends?
6. How are well and sick children separated in the office setting, as well as in appointment scheduling?
7. If your doctor is too busy to see my child, who will handle the overload?
8. Are evening, weekend or early morning hours available to accommodate your schedule?
9. Inquire about the nursing staff in the office. You will be in contact as much with the nurses as with the doctor.
